



## THE RICHARD AND HELEN DEVOS SCHOLARSHIP - 2026

The Richard and Helen DeVos Scholarship was established in 2021 by the Rotary Club of Grand Rapids Charities Foundation to honor the legacy of Richard and Helen DeVos and their commitment to education. A generous gift from the Richard and Helen DeVos Foundation to the Rotary Club of Grand Rapids Charities Foundation allowed for the creation of this scholarship to support an outstanding **Michigan resident** with tuition and related expenses for **Graduate level programs (Masters level, Doctoral level, or advanced research pursuits)** at an accredited public or private college or university in **Michigan**. **Applicants must be enrolling/enrolled in a graduate degree program and must be a U.S. Citizen and a resident of the State of Michigan.** The scholarship recipient selected for 2026 will be awarded \$25,000.

Students enrolled or entering an accredited Michigan college or university in a graduate level program are encouraged to apply for this scholarship. An important part of the application process is a **Statement of Purpose (SoP)** (please see page 6), demonstrating why the scholarship is needed, the academic program the candidate is pursuing, career plans for the scholarship applicant, and two letters of recommendation. Once awarded, the scholarship recipient will be required to present a written report / update on October 1, 2026 and April 1, 2027, to the Chair of the Scholarship Committee of the Rotary Club of Grand Rapids Charities Foundation. The recipient may also be asked to attend a meeting of the Rotary Club of Grand Rapids Charities Foundation Board of Trustees and a Rotary Club of Grand Rapids Thursday luncheon.

This scholarship is a one-year award. However, successful recipients may apply each year for this scholarship. Applications will be due by **April 15, 2026** and will be reviewed by a Scholarship Committee comprised of Rotary Club of Grand Rapids Members appointed by the Rotary Club of Grand Rapids Charities Foundation Board. The April 15, 2026 application deadline will allow for review, candidate interviews, a final determination of the scholarship recipient by June 30, 2026, and the funding received for fall enrollment. This merit-based, needs-based, and non-discriminatory scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the completed application and personal interview. **The funds will be paid directly to the college or university on behalf of the student tuition, so a student number must be submitted by the successful candidate, as well as specified information regarding the college/university of attendance.**

The Statement of Purpose (SoP) is an essay that will tell the Richard and Helen DeVos Scholarship Committee who you are, what has influenced your career path, what your professional interests are and what you plan to do with your graduate degree. The SoP is your opportunity to speak directly to the committee via essay and make your credentials stand out from similarly qualified candidates.

Your SoP should be objective yet self-reflective. The tone of the essay should be straightforward. Your topic should be relevant and concise. Document your conclusions with specific instances or draw your conclusions as the result of individual experience. Your SoP should be no more than 250-300 words in length.

Some areas to focus on are:

- Outline your skills and qualities. How will these assist you with your graduate studies?
- Significant activities, including volunteer activities or leadership activities you have engaged in that are relevant to your degree and career aspirations.
- The professional direction you have chosen and how this degree will enable you to realize your career goals.
